City Offices Closed on Monday, January 30, 2023

City Facilities will close to the public on Monday, January 30, 2023.

The following City Facilities will be impacted:

- City Hall
- Public Works
- Municipal Court
- Public Library

Waste Connections of Texas has advised us that they are proceeding with Garbage Pick-up for Monday, 01/30/2023. Please leave your garbage cans out by the curb and they will proceed with their routes as weather permits.

As always, Public Safety Facilities and other essential City Staff will continue to be available to meet the needs of the community. City Staff are monitoring phone lines, for non-emergency questions, please call 325-625-4116.

The National Weather Service has issued a Winter Weather Advisory with a Winter Storm Watch to begin at noon. Light freezing rain, possibly mixed with sleet is expected to fall throughout the day. Accumulation of ice on city streets, road ways, and bridges will cause hazardous road conditions. Even some spots that may appear to be clear will likely have black ice. Road conditions will therefore become very icy and slippery through the day and overnight into Tuesday morning. Non-essential travel is being discouraged.

Precautionary/Preparedness actions:

- If you must travel, keep an extra flashlight, food, and water in your vehicle in case of emergency.
- The latest road conditions for the state can be obtained by calling 5-1-1.
- Slow down and use caution while traveling
- Prepare for possible power outages
