The project will consist of a 3.5 MGD Ultra Filter membrane WTP, chemical building, and high service pump station including all equipment, site work, concrete foundations, CMU buildings, electrical, generators, HVAC, instrumentation, controls, and appurtenances.

Bids may be held by the Owner for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the qualifications of Bidders prior to awarding of the contract.

A certified check or bank draft, payable to the order of the City of Coleman negotiable U.S. Government bonds (at par value) or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and an acceptable surety in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid shall be submitted with each bid.

Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.
