A RESOLUTION OF THE COLEMAN COMMUNITY COALITION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE FOLLOWING TYPE B PROJECT: TO PROVIDE FUNDS UP TO \$10,000 TO THE CITY OF COLEMAN FOR DEMOLITION OF DILAPIDATED HOMES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Coleman Community Coalition, a Type B economic development corporation (the “CCC”) has conducted a public hearing on the following project: to provide funds up to \$10,000 to the City of Coleman for demolition of dilapidated homes in the City of Coleman (hereinafter the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to housing studies performed as part of the City’s Comprehensive Plan completed in 2017 (the “Plan”), the City’s planning consultants determined that approximately 54 percent of the City of Coleman’s housing stock, both occupied and vacant, were deteriorated and/or dilapidated; and

WHEREAS, the studies and Plan also determined that housing quality has a direct link to successful economic development in a City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coleman, by and through its Code Enforcement Department, has established a housing demolition program whereby it seeks to improve the housing stock in the City by requiring the repair and/or demolition of dilapidated vacant homes which will free up vacant lots for developers to construct affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the CCC desires to assist the City in the housing demolition program; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the CCC finds and determines that the Project promotes new or expanded business development in the City of Coleman, promotes affordable housing and/or is a legal promotional expenditure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CCC:

Section 1. That the findings and premises contained in the preamble above are hereby deemed to be true and correct.

Section 2. That a public hearing on the undertaking of the Project was held by the CCC during a meeting of the Board of Directors and that notice of the public hearing was published as required by law.

Section 3. That the Board of Directors of the CCC finds and determines that the Project promotes new or expanded business development in the City of Coleman, promotes affordable housing and/or is a legal promotional expenditure and the Board hereby approves and authorizes the Project as described in this Resolution.
