OLD BUSINESS:

1. The City Council may consider, discuss, and or take actions regarding the award of bids received for health insurance, life insurance, dental insurance, and vision insurance. The City Council may choose the providers with the lowest bid or the best value bid as advertised in the City's legal notice – Mayor Tommy Sloan and Bobby Zesch of Zesch and Pickett LLP.

Health Insurance – A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Smith to remain with the BCBS grandfathered plan and to use HSA Plans #5 & #6 for a renewal rate of \$591.11 a month per employee. Councilwoman Hetzel seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0. A motion was made by Councilman McGee to dissolve the Health Reimbursement Arrangement Plan. Councilwoman Hetzel seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-1 with Mayor Pro Tem Smith against.

Life Insurance – A motion was made by Councilwoman Hetzel to accept the bid from Mutual of Omaha at \$0.110 per \$1000.00. Councilman Sides seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

Dental Insurance – A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Smith to remain with United Healthcare at a rate of \$17.59 per month. Councilman McGee seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

Vision Insurance – A motion was made by Councilwoman Hetzel to remain with Ameritas at a rate of \$7.88 per month. Mayor Pro Tem Smith seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.
