Discuss, consider, and act upon the second reading of an Ordinance of the City of Coleman adopting the Revised FY 2019-2020 Proposed City of Coleman Budget. *A motion was made by Councilman Sides to approve the second reading of the Ordinance adopting the budget amendments to the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Budget for the City of Coleman. Mayor Pro Tem Hetzel seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.*

Discuss, consider, and act upon the second reading on an Ordinance of the City of Coleman adopting the FY 2020-2021 City of Coleman Budget. *A motion was made by Councilman McGee to approve the second reading of the Ordinance approving and adopting a budget for the Fiscal Year beginning on October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021. Discuss, consider, and act upon the second reading of an Ordinance of the City of Coleman adopting an increase and establishing rates for water service to become effective October 1, 2020. *A motion was made by Councilman Sides to approve the second reading of the Ordinance adopting an increase and establishing rate for water service to become effective October 1, 2020. Mayor Pro Tem Hetzel seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.*
9. Discuss, consider, and act upon the second reading of an Ordinance of the City of Coleman adopting the property tax rate of \$0.438623 per \$100 valuation for tax year 2020. *A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Hetzel to approve the second reading of the*

Ordinance – that the property tax rate be increased for the 2020 Ad Valorem Tax Rate with the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.438623 on each \$100. Assessed value of all taxable property, which is effectively a 3.49 percent increase in the tax rate. The total tax of \$0.283330 on each \$100 assessed value shall be distributed to the General Fund for Maintenance and Operations and the total tax of \$0.155293 on each \$100 assessed value be distributed to pay the City's debt service.
