NEW BUSINESS:

1. The City Council may consider, discuss and or take actions to approve the canvass of the City Officers Election and the canvass of the Chief of Police Election as conducted on May 6, 2017 – Mayor Nick Poldrack and Karen Langley City Secretary, TRMC. Election results are as follows:
 - Mayor – Tommy Sloan – 516
 - Councilmember Place 2 West Ward – Sharlene Taylor Hetzel – 505
 - Councilmember Place 3 East Ward – Bobby McGee – 513
 - Chief of Police – Jay Moses – 257
 Anthony Smith – 335

A motion was made by Councilman Jameson to approve the canvass of the City Officers Election and the canvass of the Chief of Police Election as conducted on May 6, 2017. Councilman Smith seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.

2. The City Council may consider, discuss and or take actions authorizing the City Secretary Karen Langley to swear in the newly elected Member of the City Council and the newly elected Chief of Police – Mayor Nick Poldrack and City Secretary Karen Langley. A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Payne to authorize the City Secretary Karen Langley to swear in the newly elected member of the City Council and the newly elected Chief of Police. Councilman Jameson seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.
3. The newly elected City Council Members may assume their seats on the City Council at the conclusion of the swearing in ceremony – Mayor Tommy Sloan. Newly elect Mayor Tommy Sloan, Councilwoman Hetzel and Councilman McGee each stated it will be an honor to serve the Community.
4. The City Council may consider, discuss and or take actions regarding the appointment of a New Mayor Pro Tem to serve a one year term as per Section 2.08 of the City Charter – Mayor Tommy Sloan. A motion was made by Councilman Smith to appoint Councilman Jameson as Mayor Pro Tem. Councilwoman Hetzel seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.
5. The City Council may consider, discuss and or take actions to re-appoint City Attorney Pat Chesser to serve a concurrent term with the Mayor in accordance with Section 2.10 of the City Charter – Mayor Tommy Sloan. A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Jameson to reappoint Pat Chesser as the City Attorney. Councilman Smith seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.
6. The City Council may consider, discuss and or take actions regarding the re-appointment of Robert Nash as the Municipal Court Judge and Karen Langley as the Assistant Municipal Court Judge as per Section 6.02 of the City Charter and serving concurrent terms as that of the Mayor – Mayor Tommy Sloan. A motion was made by Councilman McGee to reappoint Robert Nash as the Municipal Court Judge and Karen Langley as the Assistant Municipal Court Judge. Councilwoman Hetzel seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.
