SBA announces Economic Injury Disaster Loan Assistance

Coleman, Texas-The City of Coleman and the Coleman EDC would like to share some resources for our small businesses that may be impacted by COVID-19 disruptions to your business.

Governor Abbott has requested the Economic Injury Disaster Declaration for Texas through the SBA. The SBA has now **announced** that any Economic Injury Disaster Loan assistance declaration issued by the SBA makes loans available statewide to small businesses and private, non-profit organizations to help alleviate economic injury caused by the Coronavirus (COVID-19).

According to the SBA the Texas SBA Coronavirus declaration website should be opened for loan applications in the next 24-48 hours.

to complete their profile and get registered. This will enable the Registrants to be notified by email as soon as the website will accept access to the SBA Coronavirus Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL) application process.
