## **City lifts boil water notice for Hillside Residents**

The City previously issued a precautionary notice for customers in the area of Austin Street to Hillcrest and West of Martin Street to Holiday Hill Nursing Home. Customers are no longer required to boil water used for drinking, cooking, and making ice. Water quality testing submitted to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has confirmed that tap water meets all regulatory standards and is safe to drink. The boil water notice has been lifted.
