NOTICE OF PUBLICATION

Section 2.14 of the City Charter requires that the City of Coleman publish the descriptive caption of any ordinance which is passed AND which contains any penalty, fine or forfeiture for any violations of any provisions of the ordinance. The City of Coleman recently passed a new ordinance regarding public access to Lake Scarborough which does include provisions for penalties or fines for failures to comply with the provisions outlined within the Ordinance. The following descriptive caption is therefore being printed in the Coleman Chronicle and Democratic Voice on January 26, 2023 to fulfill the charter requirements. This Ordinance will become effective after this publication in the Coleman newspaper. The descriptive caption reads as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COLEMAN, TEXAS, AMENDING AND SUPERSEDING ORDINANCE NO. 979, BY CLOSING PUBLIC ACCESS TO CITY OWNED LAKE SCARBOROUGH AND ITS SURROUNDING PROPERTY; PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A CUMULATIVE REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The penalty for violations of the ordinance is a fine of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$200.00 upon conviction.
