

**ORDINANCE NO. 1161**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLEMAN, TEXAS ESTABLISHING REVISED FEES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE OF PRESS MORRIS PARK AT LAKE COLEMAN; PROVIDING A CUMULATIVE REPEALER CLAUSE FOR INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS OF OTHER ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Coleman hereby desires to revise the fees charged for the use of Press Morris Park at Lake Coleman; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLEMAN, TEXAS:**

**Section 1. Press Morris Park Fee Ordinance.**

The following fees are hereby established for the use of Press Morris Park at Lake Coleman:

<b>Press Morris Park User Fees:</b>	<b>Fee</b>
Full Hookups	\$20.00 per day
Partial Hookups (w/ electricity)	\$15.00 per day
Primitive Camping (no/electricity)	\$10.00 per day
Day Rate (per individual and family)	\$8.00 per day
½ Day Rate (per individual and family)	\$5.00 per day

**Section 2. Cumulative Repealer.** This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all other ordinances and shall not repeal any of the provisions of other ordinances except those instances where there are direct conflicts with the provisions of this Ordinance. Ordinances or parts thereof in force at the time of this Ordinance shall continue to be in effect and ordinances or parts thereof that are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.

**Section 3. Severability.** If any section, article, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word in this Ordinance, or application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance, and the City Council

hereby declares it would have passed such remaining portions of the Ordinance despite such invalidity, which remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 4. Savings Clause.** All rights and remedies of the City of Coleman are expressly saved as to any and all violations of the provisions of any ordinances affecting and which have accrued at the time of the effective date of this Ordinance; and, as to such accrued violations and all pending litigation, both civil and criminal, whether pending in court or not, under such ordinances, same shall not be affected by this Ordinance but may be prosecuted until final disposition by the courts.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage, in accordance with law.
